Transcript of Pre-Recorded World Satsanga by Guy Steven Needler:

"Welcome to this World Satsanga held on the 27th of June 2020 in conjunction with Kevin Moore and The Moore Show. And again Kevin is still working on his series, which is now into its 61 or 62 people he has interviewed to discuss the different ways in which they channel information from Source or from spirit or from any other entities that are available within the Source's multiverse and he's doing a fantastic job. And I am noting that my own particular interview, which was one of the first, as it happens, is #58, so if you go into his YouTube Channel, look for "They Call Us Channelers." It's part of The Moore Show or Moore Talk, you'll see my particular interview there. It's an hour and a half long.

Okay, so this particular Satsanga is just going to be focusing on the question of: What were the great civilizations within the physical universe, which is a big ask actually, because the physical universe, as you can imagine, has a lot of different galaxies in there. You know, billions of galaxies, so it might be just too much to contemplate in any great detail. Most of the questions I note, although they say the physical universe, which is really sort of rotating around those civilizations that may have interacted with us an incarnate entities on this particular planet, but also may have visited us from different galaxies. But also most of it is within the galaxy.

There's another question, which is part of it, which is: What is the truth surrounding the Council of Twelve? These twelve entities that are supposed to be looking after the physical universe. And a lot of the local galaxies surrounding how we basically interact with the physical universe and use the incarnate vehicles that we have to allow us to allow us to experience an accelerated level of evolution as a function incarnating in these low frequency vehicles. Sometimes one of them is called the human body and there's lots of different variations on that.

So I'm going to do that and then the very end of the Satsanga, we're going to go through giving a rather pertinent right now meditation on giving **unconditional forgiveness**. Okay, so I think there's lots of forgiveness required all over the world in all sorts of different ways, from all sorts of sides right now, which is something that is I think missing in a lot of things that are going on right now around the world.

Part 1. Lecture on "What are major civilizations in the physical universe?"

So let's have a look at major civilizations. I'm not going to mention the popular civilizations that come from around the **Pleiadian** area, the **Sirian** area or the **Arcturian** area, because there's a lot of existing, shall we say, text surrounding these particular locations with the civilizations that have visited the Earth being classified as being Arcturians or Pleiadians or Sirians, which is simply just a location that we've given it. I mean these particular locations are star clusters, of course. They can be seen with our telescopes from Earth and they do have entities that have visited the Earth. In fact, they are quite close to us in real terms.

And although they have a decree set forth that they can't particularly interfere with us, they have walked amongst us at a different frequency. Now what I will say is the Sirians and the Pleiadians and the Arcturians are a frequency higher than the gross physical aspect of the human form is, so their lowest frequency of manifestation of the vehicles that they use to move around this particular local area of the physical universe is around the fourth frequency level [FB 4]. So we don't see them basically. We don't, as I've said in previous discussions or lectures, they're above our visual range. They're above the detectable range of our machinery, because most of our machinery is based upon the visual range of the eye, not surprisingly enough.

(5 min) And so we need to look at devices that can look at or observe the frequencies well above the visual eye, something probably well into, you know, 10,000 nanometer range and above to be able to get any reasonable idea of what's also walking around the Earth and the other local areas within our solar system and the local part of the galaxy that we just don't see with our particular current sensory perception.

So these three I'm not going to focus on. What I will say though, there's a lot of, shall we say, metaphysical or spiritual art work out there that depicts them as being humanoid, and this isn't particularly true. The humanoid body is quite a common form in various different, shall we say, genres. But the depiction of them being tall, thin with long, blonde hair and being very beautiful, almost like the Aryan race is not specifically true. They do have humanoid shapes. Some of those humanoid shapes are, shall we say, only humanoid in terms of the way in which they can perambulate and the way that they may work with any tools or any objects or any machinery or any devices that they create.

Most of the **spiritual art** or metaphysical art is based upon personal desires. Some of it is based upon expectations, based upon what they expect to see. And those individuals who have observed these different incarnate entities will have probably had some form of translation effect happening within their consciousness, so that they can observe what's there. Translation is something that we use, it's not just a verbal thing, like a language thing. It's based upon our experience in this particular incarnation, so anything that we can see or do see that is not normal to this particular frequency level, there will be an element of translation that happens, if it's outside of our normal level of expectation or experience.

Okay, so we do tend to give things a human level of understanding. And in some respects that's why the **Greys** and the **Whites** incarnate bodies are, shall we say, very plain bodies are quite a popular thing to observe, because that is the way in which the human mind, the incarnate human mind will see these entities. They see them as being humanoid and the part of them, which is not particularly humanoid or is difficult to ascertain, shall we say, or understand as being humanoid is basically white washed by our consciousness, our human consciousness, while we're here, so we're given the plain body type rather than what they are.

And in fact, you could argue that what we see isn't actually their body type, because what they look like, although they are quite small, the Greys are quite small compared to the Whites, that is basically a protective layer that they've got. It's more of a biological skin, but it's not part of what they are. It's simply a protective covering that they have to protect them from the environment that we have here, the different gases as part of our atmosphere here.

So would I classify the Greys as a great civilization or the Whites as a great civilization? Well, it's well known that the Greys are working in service to the Whites. Those of you, who don't know that, well, that's what they do. They're not a subspecies, they are simply a species of incarnate vehicle that are happy to be of service to another species of incarnate vehicle that have a, shall we say, somewhat more interaction with the physical aspect of this particular galaxy, and sometimes other localized galaxies, because they can travel quite some distances in the vehicles they use.

(10 min) If you want to know more about the vehicles that they can use and the levels without knowing or understanding the body types, then go on to my website and look for the Events and Lectures page, or the Events tab and go on to the Lectures page and you will see the pdf files. There might even be a couple of video links there that relate to the Lecture called "Who We Are and How We Incarnate." You'll definitely see that video on the Glastonbury Symposium and it's also being in the Cardiff Event that we had last year as well, one about June, I think it was, if you look for that. Also the Swansea UFO Network as well, they've got a copy of that particular

presentation as well. So these entities, they're mostly of service, mostly of observation, mostly of maintenance, so to speak, with the area that we exist within.

Now in terms of great civilizations, I really feel it's pointless in naming them, because it will mean nothing to people. But I will say that within the physical universe and the third frequency level associated with the physical universe — because of course there's twelve frequencies for those of you, who follow the work, associated with the physical universe — and the physical universe is the only universe that has twelve frequencies [FB 1-12]. It is very important to understand that there are incarnate entities that exist on each of these different levels from the 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th and 12th.

And those that exist on say the 4th frequency, we won't see, because we don't have the sensory perception or the machinery to be able to observe what's on the 4th frequency level. But those on the 4th frequency level can observe and work with what's on their own frequency level and they can drop down to the 3rd if they want to. But they can't observe and work with what's on the 5th unless they've got the right technology that enables them to translate up to those levels. If you go to the 6th, for instance, you get the same thing. Entities on the 6th can interact with those on the 5th and 4th or 3rd, if they've got the right machinery to bring them down to those frequency levels. But they can't interact with those on the 7th naturally again unless they've got the technology to do it.

And so each of the levels within the physical universe has got a whole group of incarnate vehicles relevant to the frequency they're on that we can incarnate into. And as you go higher up the frequencies, the number of incarnate vehicles that are scattered around the different galaxies within the physical universe starts to get greater in number, basically. And this is the interesting thing that we need to understand is that in real terms the number of civilizations that are out there is huge. A number of them have actually moved beyond the need to, whilst being incarnate, interact with lower frequencies. They've moved beyond the need to interact with other civilizations that are within the physical universe as well.

Most of those that we interact with, or should I say, most of those that we recognize are from the local area of this particular galaxy. **The Earth is in quite a remote place.** It's right at the very end or almost close to the very end of one of the spiral arms of this particular galaxy that we call Milky Way. And it's therefore in a really quite, shall we say, limited area in terms of the number of civilizations or incarnate civilizations that are around us. Now clearly the decree the Earth is a **quarantined area**, because of the experimentation on individualized free will has an effect in terms of the civilizations that can visit us. But they do observe what's happening and they are interested to see how we get on, because once the experiment in individualized free will bears the right level of fruit — that being that we start to work better as a group of entities.

(15 min) We work in service to each other. We don't have any discrimination toward anything at all. We all have the same level of experiences in terms of our status, our roles. All roles are important. We don't get the variations in living experience in terms of, you know, some people live in abject poverty vs. other people live in abject affluence. Everything is leveled off. And we start to work with the benefit of everything we do is for the benefit of everybody else as well, then we're going to start to see other civilizations become more obvious to us and start to interact with us, because we will have learned that greed and status and power don't mean anything, when we've got the ability to use Love and Wisdom to temper the potential Power that we may have for the benefit of all.

So surrounding this planet within this particular galaxy is quite a lot, quite a large number of civilizations that have survived, because they are a collective or they work in a collective sense. You could classify some of them as being great, if you wanted to, but what I want you to just very quickly understand what great means. A **great civilization** is one that has recognized its

place within the galaxy within the physical universe within the multiverse. It's progressed beyond the opportunity for self-gain, even though you're working as a collective, you wouldn't have that as such. It's progressed beyond the desire to have individualized free will, because although civilizations are working in various different forms of loose collective condition, they don't specifically, or should I say, they understand that individualized free will is available to them, so they don't specifically crave it, because they understand that it's a potential route to disaster. And you only need to see what's happening around our particular planet right now to understand that it's creating a significant amount of disaster right now.

I keep saying this, so people might think I'm deflecting the question, but basically there's that many civilizations out there that are in the so-called independently great mature state. It's just difficult to single them out, as to say one is better than another. If you single one out, then you are saying that this particular civilization is better than another. And that's not the case. What I will say is that, if you wanted to give a number for the number of civilizations that have achieved the status of being great, and that means that they are working together in harmony for the betterment of the collective in a form of communion, which will mean that they may have individual will, but it's not individually free will. What I mean by that is that they're able to work on an individual basis, but the product of their work has to benefit the whole to be validated basically, and by validated, I mean to allow them to do it.

So everything that has to be done has to be for the benefit of the whole. It's a bit like us doing something, such as being a farmer, and the benefit is that the produce of the farm is for the benefit of a large amount of individuals. Whereas if somebody is working in an office as a clerk, for instance, what are they doing? What they are doing is maybe some administration work that is of the benefit of the whole, let's say, the organization or the company, and that organization or company has something, which benefits the rest of the world or the country that they're in. Those are the sorts of things.

So the number of civilizations that have reached this level of greatness where everything is being done for the benefit of the whole. Maybe some of them have gone straight into greatness. They've been mature enough to understand the pitfalls of having individualized or some form of will that creates that potential for doing things that is not for the benefit of the group. And they, maybe as a result of that, that collectively, they've almost got to the point of almost destruction, whereas some of them have bypassed it straightaway and gone straight into greatness, which is what I was going to say in the first place.

(20 min) So there are those that have gone to greatness straightaway, because they've understood the pitfalls. There are those who've gone into the pitfalls and come out the other side. And there are those who haven't achieved greatness at all and they have collectively destroyed themselves or destroyed the possibility of that particular incarnate vehicle progressing further and giving the opportunity for, or shall we say, incarnate evolutionary opportunity within that particular location within the physical universe in that particular frequency as well.

So let me get down to these numbers then. When you consider that scientists and astrophysicists have observed within the **observable universe** — that's what we can see even with our telescopes — something as an estimation between 200 billion and 2 trillion galaxies, then to say that there's much more than that is probably going to blow up most people's minds. There's at least a thousand times more than that. So that's a thousand times the estimation between 200 billion to 2 trillion, because there is a supposed edge to the universe. And that's based upon its frequential state at that level. But those numbers, by the way, are just in the visible universe. And for us, or I should say, for scientists that's the observable universe, that's within the first three frequencies of the twelve frequencies.

So you can understand that that will be duplicated by a much bigger number, as we start to go up the frequencies and see the other galaxies that exist within the 4th frequency, the additional galaxies in the 5th, the additional galaxies in the 6th, the additional galaxies in the 7th, etc., etc., etc. So what I'm going to do is just focus upon the number of great civilizations that are within this estimation of 200 billion to 2 trillion galaxies that scientists have decided that there are in the observable universe within the first three frequencies. I mean it's a big difference, if you think about it — 200 billion to 2 trillion is a massive difference in estimation.

But what I'm being told is the number of great civilizations within our particular galaxy, let's just wind it back down to our galaxy, rather than getting involved in all these other billions of galaxies or even trillions of galaxies within the physical universe in the observable or the first three frequencies associated with our universe. And I'm being told there's **1,173 great civilizations**. Now in the past I've said there's billions of civilizations and there are, but that's within the physical universe, because there's these other frequencies we have to deal with as well. But just in this galaxy, just in the galaxy, 1,173 — that is a lot of great civilizations just in one galaxy.

That doesn't take into account civilizations that are not so great, such as the human race, for instance on Earth. So there's lots and lots and lots of other civilizations that are either enjoying various different levels of technological or should we say spiritual advancement that are not in the classification of "great" yet, but they will do. And the numbers of those I'm being told are over 5 times as many. I'm just checking that number. Hang on, actually I forgot the zero. It's actually 11,730 great civilizations, which when you think about the number of stars that are in our galaxy, which is around, let's say, an average of 250 billion stars, then that's plus or minus almost the same figure. It's plus or minus 150 billion.

(25 min) So the average of 250 billion is either a 100 billion or it's 400 billion, depending upon how you look at it and the particular angle I suppose and the devices that you use. So 11,730 great civilizations is actually, you know, when you think about the number of stars, and the number of stars that have got the potential for at this third frequency level for having a suitable environment, either in orbit to the star or close to the orbit of the star, is actually not a lot. So it's a very small amount in real terms. And I'm told that the number of civilizations that are in the galaxy that are various grades of advancement, let's say from medieval to even caveman level up to highly technological, but not highly advanced to the point of being called great.

So there's 5 x 11,730 civilizations out there that aren't classified as great, which is interesting because if you think about it, that means that if you say that the 11,730, which is one of six (1 of 6), so a total of 6 x the number of civilizations out there. And of that 11,730, one sixth of them, because there's five others, okay, that aren't great, is great. So it shows that there's a one in six chance of being great, and that's civilizations that are out there that are classified as being advanced, not great. If you also realize that, you know, it's very likely that's there's many more civilizations out there, because we can have 2, 3, 4, 10, you know, 100s of different civilizations on a planet.

Because on Earth right now we have a number of different civilizations on the planet. We don't just have what we call mankind, because before we start to get together, we have little groups of civilization. And a civilization is basically classified as a process by which a society or place reaches an advanced stage of social and cultural development and organization. Well, you don't need to have technology to do that. I mean the American Indians had that. The Indians or the indigenous species in the rainforest have that. The Aborigines in Australia have that. So as long as it's got society, culture and a way of life of a particular type, it's classified as being a civilization.

So you could understand that although this seems like a strange ratio, where 11,730 civilizations are great, and then 5 times that is what aren't great, but they are still technologically advanced,

it means that one sixth of the total number of civilizations or recognizable civilizations in the galaxy have some level of technology, but one sixth of them is great is a strange ratio. So look at it from a different perspective, and you start to realize that that's just those that are classified as being one big civilization on the planet, not the number of civilizations in total within the galaxy. Because the number of civilizations in total will multiply by the number of civilizations that are on underdeveloped planets, where there's groups of incarnate entities that are working together but in isolation to each other.

And so it's quite possible that a planet might have 30-40 or 100-200 civilizations on there. Or groups of incarnate entities that are classified as being civilized, because they're working in a society based way or a culturally developed way that means that they all work together to perpetuate their own existence. Think of it like the Dark Ages on Earth. There's lots of groups of civilization, villages, many kingdoms. There's lots and lots of kingdoms within the UK, for instance, and each of these could be classified as a localized civilization in their own right.

(30 min) So there's lots and lots and lots of civilizations well above and beyond this 11,730 great civilizations, and then the additional 5 times that, which are developed civilizations that would be global, for instance, and then you've got the massive amount of smaller civilizations on those planets where there's pockets of civilizations in various different locations on those planets as well

The **form factors** that these civilizations take. Let's stick with the great ones. All those that move around the environment, the galaxy — not specifically all the galaxies within the universe, just one galaxy — are multipolous. That's a good word, isn't it? And that means that there's lots and lots and lots of different types. And there are those that are quite obviously insectoid. There are those that are almost humanoid with different types of humanoid. Humanoidness — there's humans that have got multiple numbers of legs. In fact, if you look at some of the historical images of centaurs or minataurs or even angels, for instance, they are humanoid in shape, but with things like wings or a horse's body or with a bull's head.

My understanding is these have come from various different levels of understanding of observation, but some of them have come from Atlantis, for instance. And same with the so-called mermaids, for instance. They were genetically modified bodies that would allow the individuals to exist beneath the sea and also obviously breathe or get oxygen or extract oxygen from the water. So it's another level or form of gilling type of system, which isn't represented in real terms in much of the old art work.

So the number of body types are certainly vast. I keep saying this, Look at the number of bodies or the number of animals, insects, birds and fish, that there are on the planet, on this particular planet Earth and you'll see the number of body types that are available in the rest of the physical universe — certainly in this galaxy as well. These are all carbon-based forms as well. These are the forms that use an atmosphere of some sort, whether it's a dense atmosphere, such as an ocean or whether it's a higher frequency atmosphere, such as air — what we've got here now, you know, what we breathe that is air-based or there might be other gases that they breathe as well.

So there's lots of these different body types. And some of them have visited the Earth. We've seen some of them. Some of them are even reptilioid and for some strange reason, they've got quite a bad reputation for some reason. I would argue that it's just their image, their body type that gives them the bad reputation and the uneducated observations of what they may be doing, if they're being observed doing various different things, which has also causes, shall we say, a bad rap on them, so to speak.

But the civilizations that are close to us, that have been observed, without a doubt have been looking and seeing what's going on the Earth in terms of this experiment in individualized free will. And some of them, most of them will have displayed some level of body type that, shall we say, is acceptable to the human mind. And therefore, it will be of a humanoid type, just to make sure that we don't have a problem with understanding the different body types.

We accept the humanoid body type in various different ways, different genres. I mean look at the different science fiction films that have been springing up all over the place now for the last certainly 70 years plus. They're all based upon some form of common life form, and they're all based upon, well, obviously, there's the odd variation on that, but there are some crystalline entities that have been portrayed in certain films and certain series.

(35 min) But in general they end up being some form of humanoid shape, but maybe a reptilian face or a bird-like face or some of the bizarre mutation that tries to set them aside as being humanoid but from a different planet. So these entities have visited the Earth. Some of them are great, in terms of their status of being a great civilization, but there are lots of them and this figure we've gone through previously is an example of that.

The galaxy is quite a small area. It looks massive, you know, we talk about these 250 billion stars as being plus or minus 150 billion, and you can think about the number of planets that are rotating around some of these stars. Some of them have no planets at all, of course. Some of them have lots and some of those planets have moons. And if you think about that it doesn't have to be a planet to have the ability to support an incarnate vehicle, the moons can as well. In our particular solar system might have, let's say, three or four different incarnate vehicle opportunities, because the environment supports them — the environment on these different either planets or moons supports them.

So it's quite possible that there are civilizations in one, let's say, there's as an example sixteen civilizations within one particular solar system of a number of planets, and each planet with a number of moons on them. And a large number of those moons and planets can support some form of environment that allows an incarnate vehicle to be able to survive and operate within it.

I guess the most popular thing with understanding what a great civilization is what have they done, what have they achieved, how has mankind interacted with them? When they have interacted with mankind, have they planted the seeds of civilization? Have they planted the seeds of technology? And the answer is that those that have been allowed to basically operate in an almost invisible state. So although a lot of the inventions that we've had have been fed to us by higher frequency incarnate entities in communication with other souls incarnate in a human body here, and sometimes they've been given to them by their guide and helpers to get them to assist in the development of the human race by giving them the idea of inventing certain technologies that are going to be beneficial to us, it's not always the case.

Some of us incarnate with a contract or some expectation of doing work with another civilization that are incarnate, that are higher frequency. But the souls that they're going to work with within that particular incarnate civilization of a higher frequency, for instance, have got a role to play with this particular individual and they will contact it and it will give information or create inventions, for instance, or work on different technologies or part of technologies or give the key towards the advancement of certain technologies, that means that we progress as well in a certain way. And that doesn't just mean technology, it could also be spiritual advancement, or it can also be medical technology as well, or ways in which we can work with our environment better, or ideas about how to work with the environment in a more caring and understandable way.

One this is for sure though, there's a big emphasis on the council looking after us, a **Council of Twelve**. My understanding is that there are a group of entities that are working with the physical universe. And there are a group of entities that support each of those frequencies within the physical universe. And those entities are based upon by and large by the number twelve, because it's a special number that is part of the structure of the Origin, which has been passed down as part of the structure of the Source Entities and our particular Source Entity.

(40 min) So there's not just one Council of Twelve, there are basically ten Councils of Twelve. There is a Council of Twelve associated with the first three frequencies, because this is the manifestation of physicality — the lowest frequency where we can start to create an incarnate human vehicle is the combination of the first three frequencies. Then you've got a Council of Twelve at the 4th frequency, a Council of Twelve at the 5th, etc., etc.,

And these are basically representatives from so-called great civilizations, who are working with the perpetuation of the...on the ground level, so to speak, that are working together to help those who are incarnate or incarnating to evolve in a faster way. So everything they work with is trying to guide in some way, shape or form the direction that certain incarnate races are going into, because obviously when we're incarnate, we don't recognize who and what we are. So we sometimes need direction, you know. We need leaders in certain points in our existence to be able to attract our attention and give us motivation and help us think in the right way and behave in the right way and act in the right way as well. So there's these ten Groups of Twelve on the so-called physical level.

There's also an overall group, which certainly from the human perspective are disincarnate. But they've been working on the overall development of the physical vehicles, which we incarnate into. So this group worked with the human body and other forms or versions of the human form to allow it to cope with the different frequential changes that have happened over the period that we've used the incarnate vehicle to experience, learn and evolve on this particular planet. And they also have Groups of other Twelve, who work with other incarnate vehicles as well.

So in essence, for every sort of overall genre of vehicle type, there's another Group of Twelve that are disincarnate, that are working with them and looking at how they can be modified, how it needs to work. We call it Darwinian evolution when the body type changes over a period. But in actual fact, it's modification through genetic manipulation using other entities that are incarnate to help with the genetic manipulation by planting seeds or changing things energetically, so the body is changed in different ways. The energy templates create the human form. There's seven energy templates that create the human form. Of course, these have a chakra associated with them to generate the energy that allows it to be animated.

So there's all these modifications to the body types, the vehicle types out there. And so there's this Group of Twelve that are disincarnate entities that are helping to modify and make sure the human form can cope with different frequential changes. Within both the incarnate over various different frequencies and the nonincarnate conditions, these individuals that are part of the Twelve, these various different groups of Twelve, they rotate. So it's not, shall we say, a permanent role, there's always rotation. Certainly within the energetic, there's always rotation of different entities that are coming and going to participate in being part of the governance of the environment that support it in the various different frequencies of the physical universe.

But in terms of the Councils of Twelve in the different frequency levels, the 3rd, or I should say, the collective first, the 3rd, the 4th, 5th, etc., etc., they are of the groups of civilizations that are classified as being great. So for instance, there may be a period where the representatives from twelve civilizations, these great civilizations are working with the Earth. Then one of them might change, for instance, one of the twelve might change and another one of those great civilizations may come in and participate. And so it's not a guaranteed job for eternity, being part

of this Council of Twelve, the individuals who are on these councils change and rotate and new entities come in and old entities go out, for instance. And a new entity might come in and only be there for a short period, whereas another one might come in and stay for a longer period, like millennia.

(45 min) So it's depending upon the work that that particular entity has got to do to be part of this Council of Twelve, it might be a few years from our perspective, but it might end up being a few millennia, for instance, if they are working at a higher frequency and their body types last a lot longer, and the work that they're doing needs to be observed over a longer period for whatever reason and for the project that they're working on.

Okay, so I've not named any names for obvious reasons, well, for reasons that there are lots and lots and lots of them. There's a popular number of them, a group of entities that are known to people and there's no point in changing that, because that's what they are. They're there. The Pleiadians, the Arcturians, Sirians. There's the Grahoopnik, which are not too far from where we are, which I've mentioned in "The History of God." There's lots of other civilizations that are out there that are classified as being great, the 11,730. There's five times more that are not in that status, but they're still advanced.

And there's countless thousands of others, perhaps even I'm being told, billions of others, which are grouping together and acting in a civilized way, but don't have spacefaring capability or don't even have the capability to understand that there's other groups like them even on the same planet, or even on the same moon surrounding the planet. So there's lots and lots and lots of them out there. And the physical universe certainly, and certainly the local galaxy that we exist within, is continuously accepting the potential for more and more body types to be available in various different environments to give us a complete diversity of experience at different frequencies or different locations even within this particular group of three gross physical frequencies as well. So there's always lots of chances to introduce a new body type or a new variation of an existing body type to allow it to work in a different environment as well.

So nearly 50 minutes of talking and lots of understanding there about what is very generalized, very high level. And I don't think there's any need to go into a lower level, because there's lots of it out there. But some of it is not as high level as it should be. Some of it is very human centric, because of this thing, where people observe things and they translate it into being what they expect or what they would like to see rather than what it is.

Part 3. Meditation

(48 min) Okay, so what we're going to do now is go into end of Satsanga meditation. And I know before I even go there that, because I haven't gone into the locations or the directions that some people might have wanted me to go into, like naming another five or six civilizations that are close by us and when are they going to come to the Earth? How many are going to come and when will they become visible to us?

I've definitely not gone down that route, because personally I don't think it's...we should be thinking bigger. We should be thinking more in depth. We should be thinking higher frequency rather than sort of on the lower frequencies where we are. If we want to stay in medieval ages, then we continue to think in a medieval way, we will do. If we want to think, to progress and go into a Golden Age, then we've got to be thinking outside of our particular frequential state and think of becoming part of the next frequential state. And that means that we need to think about working with civilizations that are higher frequency, when we are able to do so, and not postulate or discuss that which is there that we can't see, taste, touch [hear] or feel, and therefore, we don't have justifiable, tangible physical proof of their existence, whereas right now

we've got some levels of physical proof, because of the lower frequency incarnate vehicle entities that are traveling to and have been seen on this particular planet. If we want to stay at that level, we can do.

(50 min) My thought process and my feeling is we need to go beyond it, because that's the ultimate goal. It's to move beyond this particular frequency that we classify as the gross physical and go up at least to the next level, which is the 4th frequency level, which is the lower astral. Okay.

What I want to do now is to do the meditation now to create a level of forgiveness and basically create a level of love around the globe, because right now I feel we really do need it. So this is a meditation on giving unconditional forgiveness about everything that's happened in the past, everything that could happen in the future, allowing us to move on and not use the past as a vehicle to create anger or remove certain histories. We've got what we've got. We need to understand that that is where we are. We've got the opportunity for change. But we can only do major change by giving unconditional love and forgiveness. That is the key. Okay.
